ELCA World Hunger: 50 Years

For 50 years ELCA Lutherans have been feeding hungry people. In 1974, famine in Africa & South Asia took around 2 million lives. The Lutheran Churches that later became the ELCA responded with World Hunger Appeal. That work against hunger in the world has continued for 50 years.

THIS YEAR WE ARE CELEBRATING THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY!

The NEMN Synod is planning a Synod wide **Bike Against Hunger August 17 on the Munger Trail**. This is a 50-mile bike ride--one mile for each of the 50 years of ELCA Hunger Program. If you are interested in riding check at our church office or with Larry Nelson for a registration form. You can choose to bike all 50 or part of the trail. AND If there is interest we can organize a bike ride on the Paul Bunyan trail.

The Synod is also planning a get-together called "Walking Together" at Lutheran Church of the Cross, Nisswa, October 12. There will be workshops and other events giving information and education about world hunger. Our congregation gave \$34.87 per confirmed member. How about this year we shoot for \$50 (or more) per confirmed member as a way of celebrating 50 years. The youth going to the National Gathering in New Orleans this summer are trying to raise \$25,000 for world hunger. Their theme is "Generation zero-Hunger". They are inviting the whole church to help them make their goal.

A HUGE "Thank You" to our Vacation Bible School children and volunteers who raised \$473.63 for World Hunger this year!
