Shared Ministry Model Exploration for Salem's Future

According to the Association of Religion Data Archives, the Church Growth Movement emerged in the 1970's and 1980's. This movement was focused on helping churches grow through marketing strategies and business models of operation. Beginning in the 1990's, churches began to experience a gradual decline in membership, involvement, and giving, which continues today.

Not that long ago, churches did not employ visitation or youth pastors, custodians, secretaries, bookkeepers, and in some places, pastors worked an additional job to make ends meet. As we have witnessed all around us, many smaller and rural congregations are being forced to close or consolidate with other churches, due to insufficient funds. Churches, seminaries, and synods are opening creative conversations regarding how to keep vitally important communities of worship and ministry open, and Salem is no different.

We recognize that as we are forced to not only adopt deficit budgets year after year, but also freeze all non-essential general fund spending, something has to change. None of us want Salem's ministry or community to decline, but we also know that with cost of living increases, lack of employment opportunities, and access to housing in our area, etc. means many of us simply cannot give more than we are.

Therefore, Salem's Servant Leadership Council has been exploring the idea of what we are calling a "Shared Ministry Model" for Salem's future. In this model, we are looking at putting Salem's ministry back into your hands. We will continue to pay a bookkeeper, custodian, and are developing a ministry coordinator position rather than secretary. But the biggest change would be having a part-time pastor. We don't want Salem's ministry to suffer so have begun developing ministries such as our Accompaniment Ministry Team (lay lead home visitation and Holy Communion) and our Design Collaboration Team (in house graphic and display design).

We believe in Salem's beloved community and the work God does through us. We believe the more others see all of us doing God's work and helping our community, the more Salem will thrive. This doesn't mean that the same small group of people who do a lot of the 'stuff' around here would need to do more, but it means involving and engaging each of us to step up and help - to be church together for the sake of the world.
