Ash Wednesday Worship

March 5th at 6:30pm

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday with the mark of the cross in ashes (last year's dried up & burnt palm branches from Palm Sunday) over our baptismal mark of the cross.

We look into mirrors reflecting our mortality, true selves (even the parts we wish to hide), our beautiful selves and our God standing beside us in forgiveness, compassion, and love.

Mirror Mirror ...

Our Lenten journey takes us through 40 days (excluding Sundays which are considered "Little Easters") until we reach the cross on Good Friday. Our journey includes an honest and thorough look into our hearts, minds, and soul. We look knowing God encourages us to let go of anything that does not reflect God's love for all God has created - including ourselves, as well as knowing God's love looks back at us.

This year's theme throughout Lent and the Sundays in Lent will center on the work of reflection and the image of mirrors.

We look into our reflection with truth. compassion, and desire to reflect God's love and grace to the world God loves.

As of January 31, 2025 our General Fund is **- \$1,964.99**

Due to the adoption of a 2025 deficit budget, the SLC voted to continue the **General Fund Spending Freeze**. If you or your team want/need to spend monies from a 2025 General Fund <u>line item</u> in your ministries, consultation with the SLC is needed prior to any expenditures. This does not include monies in Designated Funds.
